SHORT COURSE  
**English Literature Appreciation**

**AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE**

The course will enable participants to interest themselves in the study of English Literature in general. Learners will appreciate the various forms of literature such as prose, biography, poetry, drama etc. and will have the opportunity to study in detail a particular example of most of the forms.

**DATES AND TIMES**

The course will be spread over ten sessions of a 2 hour duration each (20 contact hours tuition), commencing on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2010. Each session will be held on Wednesday evening from 1800 to 2000 hrs.

**COURSE STRUCTURE**

<b>Session 1:</b> Defining literature and the difference between fiction and non-fiction. Introducing the various forms of literature.	<b>Session 2:</b> The Prose (1): describing its various forms, such as essays, short stories, the novel including historical and fictional.
<b>Session 3:</b> The Prose (2): introducing great essayists, novelists and immortal titles.	<b>Session 4:</b> The Biography and auto-biography including true adventure, battles, wars and diaries
<b>Session 5:</b> The Poetry (1): introducing the various forms of poetry and well-known classical poets.	<b>Session 6:</b> The Poetry (2): appreciating classical poets such as Keats, Wordsworth, Byron, Kipling and Thomas Gray.
<b>Session 7:</b> The Sonnet: introducing Shakespeare and others	<b>Session 8:</b> The Drama (1): familiarisation with dramatic/theatrical performance.
<b>Session 9:</b> The Drama (2): appreciating well-known classical dramatists such as Shakespeare, Marlowe, Ben Jonson and others.	<b>Session 10:</b> The Fable, Fairy Tales and Folklore such as Aesop, Grimm Brothers, Andersen and others.

**EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

No previous knowledge of the subject is required. Preferably applicants should have at least completed the secondary level of education.

**COURSE FEE**

The course fee is €18.63 per person, covering tuition, course notes and materials.

**THE COURSE TUTOR**

The course tutor is Mr Anthony P. Scicluna, with a vast teaching experience. On retiring as an Assistant Head of School, he taught adult learners for the last 10 years at the Lifelong Learning Centre. He assisted adult learners to sit for the Matsec English Examinations including in his lessons appreciation of English Literature.

**CERTIFICATES**

Participants who attend at least 80% of the sessions will be awarded a Certificate of Attendance.
