



## FAQ'S Re Endeavour II Scholarship Scheme 1st Call 2022

online applications open on 20th June 2022 – 15th July 2022 (noon local time)

A step by step guide on the online application is also available on our website

1. Is this a new EU funded project?

This scheme may be co-funded by the European Social Fund Plus

2. Is an E-ID required to access the online application?

Yes. All applicants must be in possession of an E-ID

3. Can I apply for a PHD/Professional Doctorate (MQF Level 8)

No. This is not possible under the ENDEAVOUR II Scholarships Scheme but you can apply under the TESS Scheme

4. What documents are required?

Follow Clause 8 of the Regulations.

5. How big can the attachments be?

Overall, not more than **10 MB**. Save your attachments with the shortest name possible.

6. How much time, does the application takes to be filled in?

Though the application, can be saved and completed at a later stage, you are required to prepare in advance the Appendices as specified in Clause 8.01.

7. Are there any templates for the Appendices?

No. Use word document for each appendix, write your name and title for each appendix and upload each appendix in pdf. format with your online application as indicated on the form.

8. From where can I seek information/advice in relation to the Appendices?

You may seek academic/professional assistance from a person of your choice, such as academic supervisor/mentor/tutor etc....

Useful links for your research are available on the website.

9. Will my current qualifications and work experience add value to my application?

Yes. You can list your qualifications (from MQF Level 5 and higher) and your work experience on your application. ONLY the highest qualification will be considered for additional marks. Follow Clause 10.

10. Is there an age limit?

No

11. Are the applications Means Tested?

No

12. Are the applications shortlisted?

No

13. Are applications to be vetted?

Yes

14. Are applicants required to undergo an interview?

Eligible applicants will be called for an interview

15. Am I responsible to seek for a course or Educational Institution?

Yes. It is in your responsibility to seek for any course or Educational Institution interested in, that are mutually recognised by the MFHEA as per Clause 3.28 and Clause 5.02 of the Regulations.

16. Can I choose a foreign Educational Institution?

Yes. The scheme caters both for those studying in a local or foreign institution.

17. Can I choose more than one course and educational institution?

Yes it is recommended to list more than one. You can list up to 5 courses/educational institutions on your application. Please follow Clause 6.

18. Am I required to choose an Area of Study?

Yes (Clause 4.12). Applicants are required to choose from the dropdown menu on the online application form. The option 'other' is not applicable for the Endeavour II Scholarship scheme, therefore it is to be avoided.

19. Can I still apply if I am not in possession of an Unconditional Letter of Acceptance/Offer (ULA) yet?

You can apply all the same as long as you have your course and Educational Institution details in hand.

20. If awarded, can I remain engaged/or engage in employment during my scholarship?  
Yes. This applies to anyone who will be awarded.
21. If I am already in possession of a Master Degree or currently undergoing another Masters Degree, can I apply to do another Masters?  
Yes. Also, you **cannot** apply for a degree lower than your Masters Degree such as a Post Graduate Certificate etc. Please refer to Clauses 4.02.
22. I am in possession of an MQF Level 8. Am I eligible to apply?  
No.
23. My course commences before 20<sup>th</sup> June 2022. Am I eligible?  
No. Check with other schemes.
24. Can I request for an extension?  
Yes. Awardee must inform the office in writing.
25. Will there be future calls under this scheme?  
Yes. It is intended that future calls will be issued.
26. Will there be an information meeting to achieve further details for this call?  
Yes. An online information meeting will be held on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2022 afternoon. Link and time will be uploaded at a later stage.
27. How much will I be entitled if awarded the scholarship?  
Follow Clause 11 and Clause 12 of the Regulations.
28. Opening and Closing Dates of online application  
**20<sup>th</sup> June 2022 – 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022 noon (Malta Time)**
29. Are Late Applications accepted?  
No. The online system automatically shuts off the application at noon local time. Follow Clause 8.04 and Clause 8.05
30. Deadline for submission of documentation:  
In the case of the Unconditional Letter of Acceptance, MQRIC reports, academic records/transcripts/certificates and EU disability card are to be submitted via e-mail by **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2022. Follow Clause 8.04.**
31. When are interviews expected to take place?  
Interviews are expected to take place as agreed by the Selection Board. Follow Clause 9.04
32. When are results of the interview expected to be published?  
They are expected to be published by November 2022.
33. When are the grant agreements to be concluded for those awarded?  
They are expected to be completed between January and March 2023.

34. When are payments expected to be disbursed?

Process of payments is expected to start February 2023. This depends on various factors.
