

MALTA VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING AWARDS

VET/Applied Student Award – Information Sheet

This award is intended to identify a student currently following any VET programme of studies, who has excelled during his or her studies. The aim is to highlight, valorize and make visible students with outstanding coursework and performance during the academic year 2019-2020. In particular, the award will highlight the green and/or digital good practice in their learning journey.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- The nomination process will be open to teachers, trainers and lecturer within educational institutions offering VET subjects.
- Each submitted nomination would need to be supported and seconded by another person.
- Nominations are only eligible for consideration in one of the announced categories.
- Seconded by another teacher/trainer/lecturer from the same educational institution.
- The nomination should include a portfolio evidencing the initiative/s taken by the nominee within the set parameters.
- Short-listed nominees might be invited to attend a virtual interview.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Enrolled as a full-time or part-time student in a VET study programme in a licensed institution during the academic year 2019-2020.
- Resident in Malta during the academic year 2019-2020.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Demonstrates enthusiasm for learning (10%)
- Achieves above-average coursework and performance, including initiatives, creativity and clear outcomes. (25%)
- Demonstrates a good grasp of work ethics, proficiency, networking and ability to change. (25%)
- Demonstrates a good understanding of hard and soft skills. (10%)
- Demonstrates a good standard of literacy and digital competence. (10%)
- Demonstrates good personality traits. (10%)
