

## MALTA VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING AWARDS

### VET/Applied Trainer/Teacher/Lecturer Award – Information Sheet

This award is intended to identify a VET teacher/trainer/lecturer who has excelled in improving the VET learning experience or has contributed to innovative approaches to VET learning. The aim of this award is also to recognize the efforts and initiatives taken in teaching VET subjects (in particular in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic). Recognition will also be given to initiatives taken to address sustainability principles and practices.

#### NOMINATION PROCESS

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- The nomination process will be open to anyone including the general public, personnel within VET institutions, parents, colleagues, head of institution, students, employers, social partners and companies.
- Each submitted nomination would need to be supported and seconded by another person.
- Nominations are only eligible for consideration in one of the announced categories.
- The nomination should provide details of the person/action/initiative as per eligibility and selection criteria.
- During the selection process, the board will shortlist nominated persons to participate in an interview.

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

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- Nominated person should have been engaged to teach VET/Applied subjects during the academic year 2019-2020.
- Nominated persons should have been engaged with the MCAST, ITS, Secondary Schools, NCFHE-Licensed Private VET providers.
- Resident of Malta.

## **SELECTION CRITERIA**

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- Recognises excellence through quality teaching (40 marks)
- Sustainability (15 marks)
- Provides visibility of VET (15 marks)
- Builds networks (20 marks)
- Invests in professionalization of VET Trainer (10 marks)
