Catch-Up Educational Sessions (Saturday) 2022/2023

Expression of interest from amongst public officers in the grades of Teachers and Supply Teachers to teach Catch-Up Classes offered every Saturday

1. The Ministry for Education, Sport, Youth, Research, and Innovation is inviting suitable public officers in the grades of Teachers and Supply Teachers working in state schools to perform duties as cited above, for a period of 1 scholastic year, till 10th June 2023, which may be renewed for further periods.
2. **Eligibility requirements**

By the closing time and date of this expression of interest, applicants must be public officers who are in the grades of Teacher and/or Supply Teacher:

- (i) teaching in Primary state School (including Complementary and Literacy Support Teachers); **or**
- (ii) teaching the subject mentioned hereunder in Middle/Secondary/Post-Sec state School.

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3. **Remuneration**

Applicants performing duties as Teachers/Supply Teachers will be remunerated with an all-inclusive remuneration of €17.59 per hour, which includes a 40-minute lesson and any required preparation.





4. Terms and Conditions

- (i) Lessons will be delivered in person at selected regional centres as listed in the form below.
- (ii) In-Person lessons and Virtual Lessons will be held on Saturdays and will run between 09.00 and 12.00 till 1st week of June 2023.
- (iii) Whilst students attending these classes will require individualised support, teachers will be provided with information regarding the topics to be prioritised.
- (iv) Selected teachers may be required to attend an information session in preparation for the programme.

5. Submission of Applications

- (i) Applicants may apply for more than one of the options listed in section 2 above. However, it is the prerogative of MEYR to select which option to offer to the selected candidates, according to the exigencies of MEYR.
- (ii) Applicants are to submit their interest by applying on the following link: <https://forms.office.com/r/e0adt8Ypwv>, indicating your preferences by **end of business day 17.15 (Central European Time) of Friday, 27th January 2023**.
- (iii) However, due to the exigencies of MEYR, the selection process will initially consider applications received by **end of business day 17.15 (Central European Time) of Friday, 18th November 2022**. Selection will be according to teaching experience.
- (iv) Nevertheless, any occurring vacancies after the initial closing date will be filled on a first come basis until the final closing date, **end of business day 17.15 (Central European Time) of Friday, 27th January 2023**.
