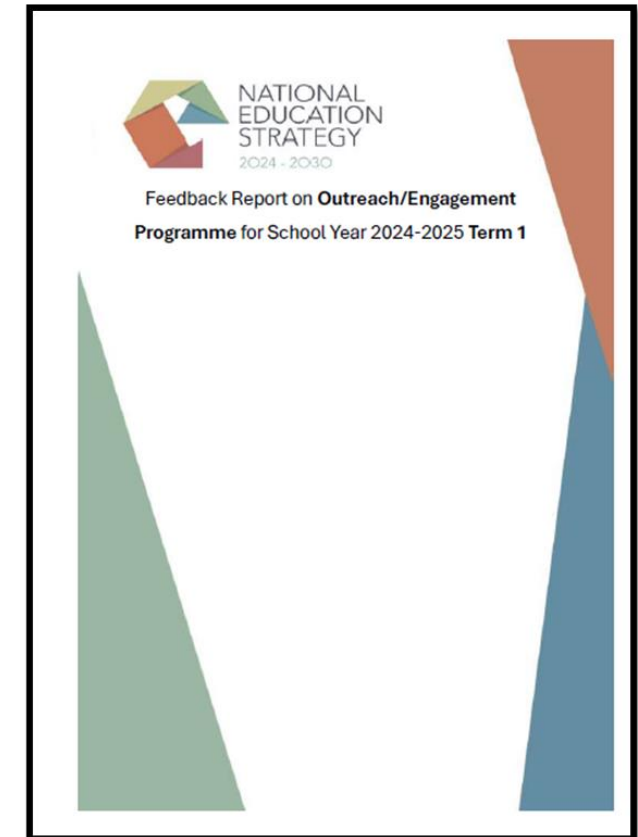

Evaluation Tools:

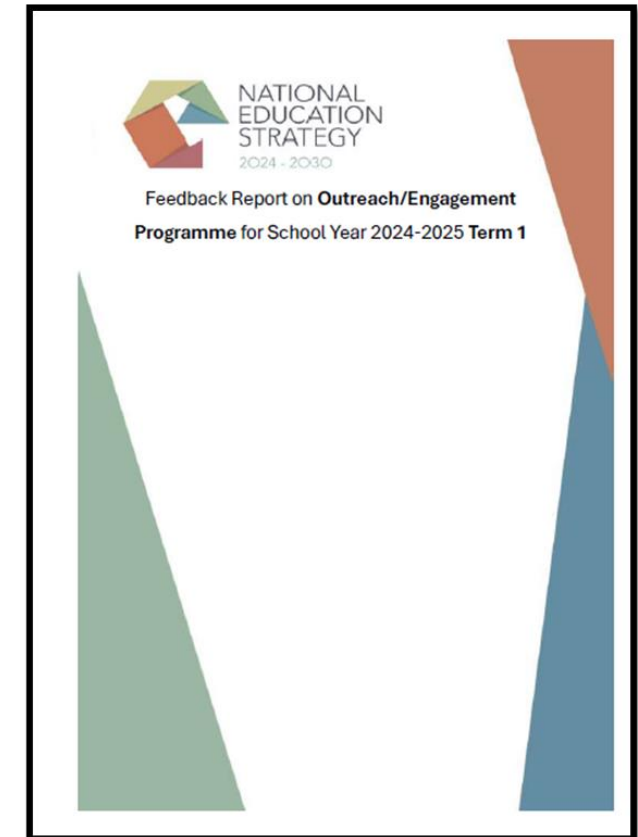
- Online Evaluation Form Completed by Heads of Schools

Evaluation:

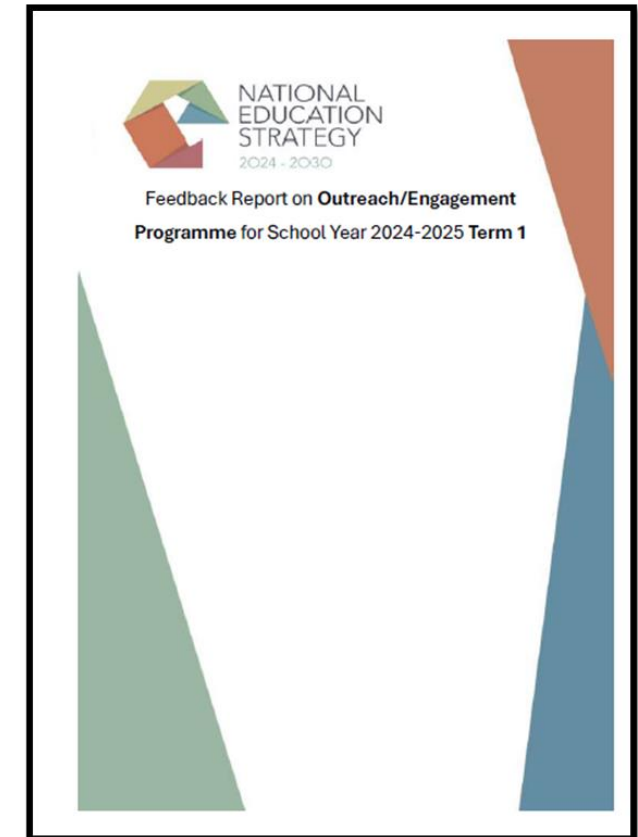
- 58.82% of Heads of Schools found information session 'good' and 41.18% 'excellent' in presenting relevant information about services.
